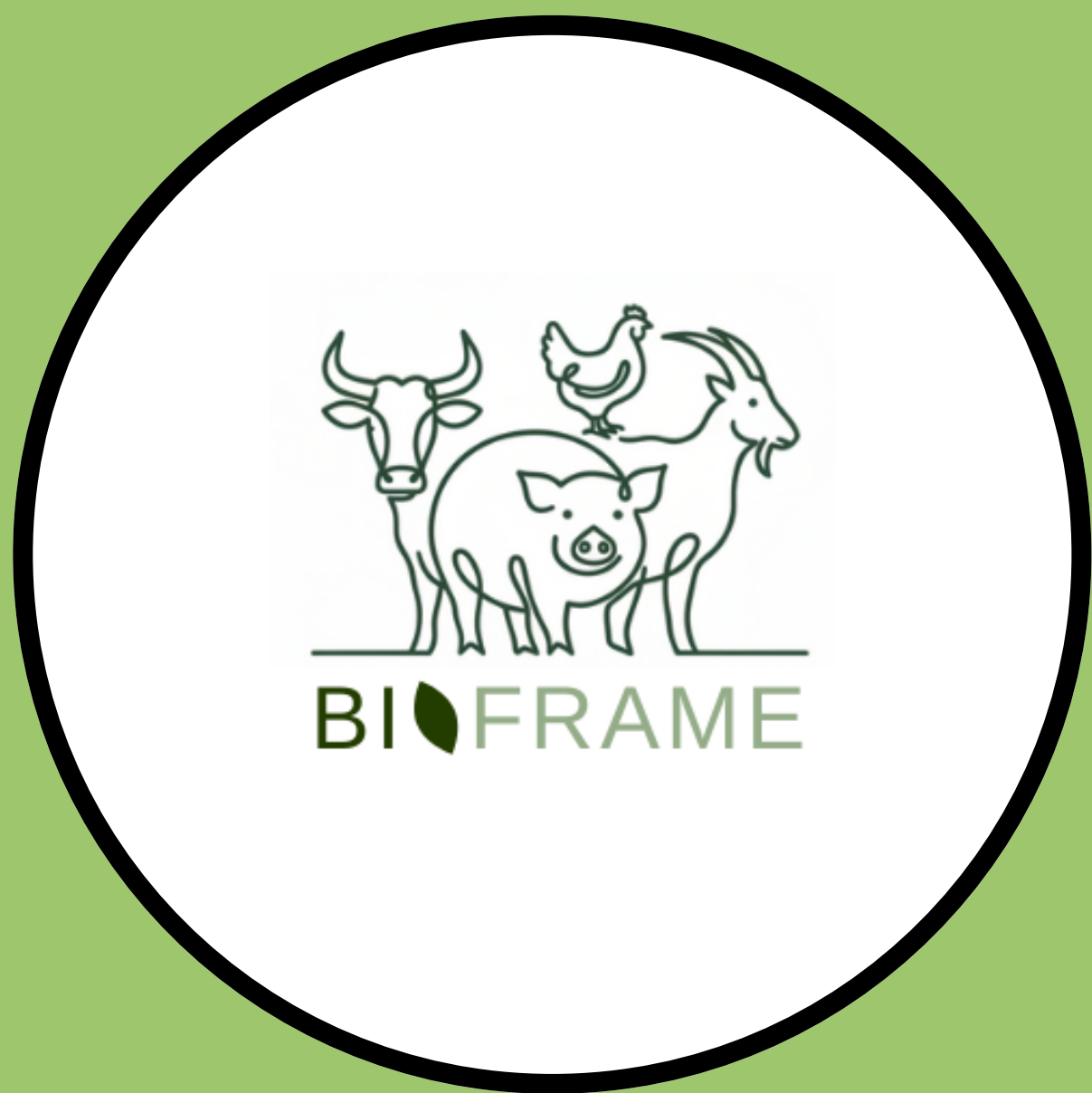




Biosecurity for Non- Intensive Farming



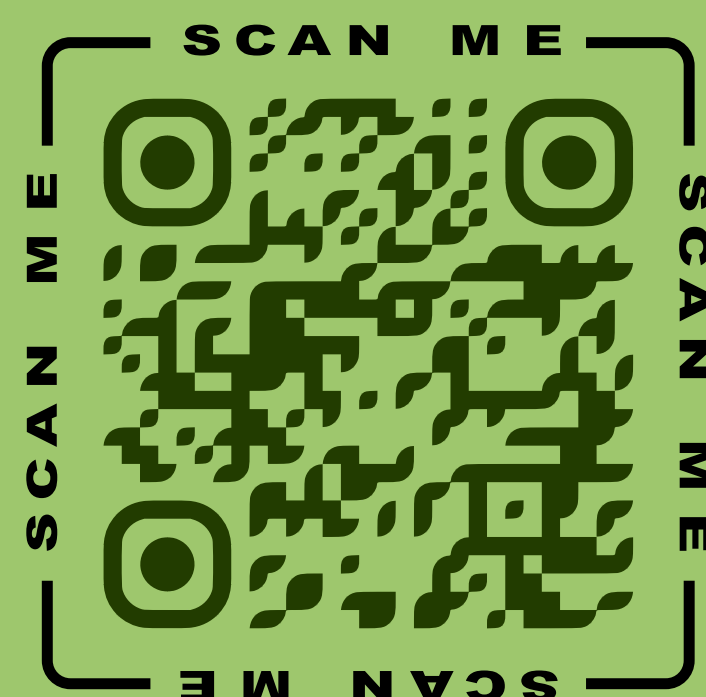
A tailored approach for animal production
